The NWP is part of the Global Water Partnership (GWP) network (under GWP-SA) - also a not-for-profit action network established to support countries in the sustainable development and management of their water resources. NWP constitutes a politically neutral multi-stakeholder platform at the country level that empowers, convenes and connects Partner organizations and other stakeholders. It also encourages Partners to work together more effectively to address water-related challenges and deliver water-related services.
